This internship will offer participation in PSRF's programs at the Chew Center for Shellfish Research and Restoration at the Northwest Fisheries Science Center's Manchester Research Station, including hatchery production of restoration–grade pinto abalone, Olympia oysters, and possibly kelp, microalgae culture, animal husbandry, data collection and management, and facilities maintenance.

- Ability to work independently and as a member of a team
- Strong self-initiative, and good attention to detail
- Follows appropriate safety practices in the lab and the field
- Preferred: Experience with marine or aquatic organism care or culture, microscopy, general laboratory equipment and procedures
